- 4 In achieving the requirements of this policy the necessary financial resources will be applied in the achievement of same
- 5 Ensuring a positive safety culture is maintained at all times through the application of "Just Culture" principles ensuring that all staff are fully engaged with SMS processes
- 6 It is the duty of all Sunair Aviation staff to at all times follow all the procedures of our SMS

In meeting the above, Sunair Aviation requires employees, contractors and visitors to participate in the Sunair Safety System (SMS) in the following way:

- 1 Timely reporting of hazards, incidents and injuries
- 2 Adherence to safety rules and procedures
